### **IX-RS Door Communication Settings**

#### Getting Started

The IX-RS audio room sub station can be configured to receive incoming calls from door stations and trigger door release. These settings add features to the station while still maintaining its primary functionality.

#### Calling the IX-RS

The door stations the IX-RS will be controlling must first be set to call the IX-RS. Click on **Station View** then expand **Call Settings** and select **Called Stations (Door/Sub Station)**. Under <u>Select Station to Edit</u>, use the **Number** drop-down menu to choose the door station that will be calling the IX-RS, then press **Select**.

#### Calling the IX-RS: Called Stations (Door/Sub Station)

In the Called Stations (Door/Sub Stations) table, click the **Open** button of the first available row. On the <u>Station List</u> window, select the IX-RS that the door station will call, then press **OK**. Repeat this process for any other IX-RS stations the door will be calling. Once all the IX-RS stations have been added, press **Update** to save the changes.

#### IX-RS Call Button: Station Information

To answer an incoming call, the functionality of the call button on the IX-RS needs to be expanded. In the left menu, select **Station Information** under **Call Settings**. Under <u>Select Station to Edit</u>, use the **Number** drop-down menu to choose the IX-RS recieving the call, then press <u>Select</u>. Use the **Call Button Function** drop-down to change the call button function of the IX-RS to **Call, Answer Call, End Communication**. Press **Update** to save the changes.

#### IX-RS Address Book: Called Stations (Door/Sub Stations)

To allow the IX-RS to call to the door station and trigger door release, the door station needs to be added to the Called Station list of the IX-RS. In the left menu, select **Called Stations (Door/Sub Stations)**. In the Called Stations (Door/Sub Stations) table, change the Group Number drop-down to Group 02 and click the **Open** button of the first available row. On the <u>Station List</u> window, select the door station to add and press **OK**. Repeat this process for any other door stations that the IX-RS will be interacting with. Once all door stations have been added, press **Update** to save the changes.

#### IX-RS Door Release Button

If the IX-RS needs to activate the door release relay of the door station, the key button will need to be activated. Expand **Station Settings** and click on **Door Release Assignment**. Under <u>Select Station to Edit</u> use the **Number** drop-down to select the IX-RS, then press **Select**. Change the Door Release by IX-RS to **Enable**, then press **Update** to save the changes.
